Please note for the first time in years, starting in 2026 non itemizers can claim a charitable deduction up to \$1,000 for single filers or \$2,000 for married couples filing jointly under the One Big Beautiful Bill Act. If you normally just toss your offering as cash into the plate (not in an offering envelope) you won't have record of this for your taxes. If you never wanted envelopes in the past but have changed your mind, please contact Leah Haas or the church office and envelopes will be issued.
