Thank you from the Community United Pantry (C.U.P.) for your generosity and help this past year! The big news for the C.U.P. was Ivadeane stepping down as the coordinator. We are truly honored and blessed to have had Ivadeane in this role since almost the inception of C.U.P. Over the years, she has grown the service from a small closet of food items that provided for a few community members to serving over 150 people per month (average of 4th quarter of 2025). Tracy Hogden, Diane & Larry Decker and Delores Stuttgart are attempting to fill Ivadeane's shoes going forward. In 2025 the C.U.P. received \$45,630.35 in donation from 63 individuals or businesses in or around our community. We spent \$35,590.68 on meat, eggs, and cheese purchases in 2025.
